- 1. Steve Jobs felt that if it were not for his fourth grade teacher, he'd wind up in jail. Why do you think he felt that way?
- 2. There were other people who influenced Steve Jobs when he was a youngster. Who were they and how did they influence him?
- 3. What were some of the benefits Steve Jobs experienced simply because of the time and place in which he lived?
- 4. How did Silicon Valley get its name?
- 5. Do you think that Steve Jobs and Steve Wozniak should have faced more serious punishment for creating their illegal phone device?
- 6. Steve Jobs made a famous speech at Stanford University. He mentioned 'connecting the dots' in a person's life. What do you think he meant by that? Can you list some of his dots? What are your own 'dots?'
- 7. Some people called Steve Jobs a 'visionary;' a person who thinks about or plans for the future with wisdom, imagination and creativity. Do you think he was a visionary? Why or why not?
- 8. A famous advertisement for Apple Computers used the term, '*Think Different*.' What does that mean to you?
- 9. Steve Jobs said he wanted to make a "dent in the universe." Who do you know, famous or not who you think has made a "dent in the universe?"
